Visit potential grantees, meet with local women leaders and participate in an international conference of young activists working to secure gender equality. You must be a member to participate.



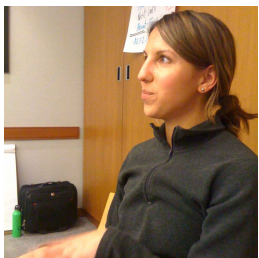
